Texas adult education ESL instructors are cordially invited to participate in the Adult Education Technology Institute, *Technology as Tool: Multimedia and Multiliteracies* held May 21, 22 and 23, 2002 at the Quality Inn in San Marcos.

Enrollment is limited to 20 participants, with a maximum of two teachers from one adult education consortium or co-op. There is a \$40.00 registration fee for each participant, payable with registration by April 19, 2002. Project Inter-ALT is providing lodging at the Quality Inn San Marcos for all participants. Local programs or participants will be responsible for all other travel expenses. There may be limited travel assistance for participants available that wish to attend and are traveling from more than 200 miles away from San Marcos. Participating instructors must have an e-mail account and be comfortable with basic computing. The institute will focus on methods of integrating multimedia technology with storytelling to motivate students to research, write, and develop personal narratives, biographies, family histories, and other projects.

All perspective participants should complete the Technology Competencies Checklist as soon as possible and return the checklist, registration form, and registration payment (check made payable to SWT Project Inter-ALT) to project staff on or before April 19, 2002.
